






Focus	<p><b>This is Me! (7 weeks)</b></p>  <p>Come and meet Little Nutbrown Hare and Big Nutbrown Hare, they are very special to each other. Who is special to you? Is it someone in your family? Do you look like them? Do you have a special friend? Nursery is a wonderful place to make new special friends and to get to know them! In this topic you will learn all about each other and take a closer look at your very special self!</p>	<p><b>The Big Freeze (7 weeks)</b></p>  <p>Meet poor little Henry! All the other baby penguins are having fun sliding on the ice and tumbling in the snow, but Henry doesn't like the cold and dreams of beaches and warm seas. When a boat sails close to the ice, Henry jumps on board and heads off in search of sunshine. It doesn't take him long, however, to realise that there's no place quite like the Antarctic. In this topic, you will get to go on your own Antarctic Adventure.</p>	<p><b>Commotion in the Ocean (6 weeks)</b></p>  <p>There's a commotion in the ocean with lots of different sea creatures having lots of fun down below. Come with us and see what it's all about as you dive deep down into the ocean and learn all about the different creatures that are waiting to be discovered. In this topic, you will learn about the features of different beautiful sea creatures and you will even get to look after your very own Nursery Goldfish!</p>	<p><b>Farmyard Friends (6 weeks)</b></p>  <p>Have you ever been to a farm? It is a very busy place with lots of different animals. What do the animals eat? Where do they sleep? Do they have a job to do? Have you ever seen a cow being milked or a sheep having a haircut? In this topic, you will learn all about what it is like on a farm and the very important jobs that the animals and the farmers do! Come along and listen to the cock-a-doodle-doo in the Barnyard Hullabaloo!</p>	<p><b>Rumble in the Jungle! (5 weeks)</b></p>  <p>There's a rumble in the jungle, there is a whisper in the trees, the animals are waking up and rustling all the leaves. Some animals are frightening and some animals are kind so come along into the Jungle and see what we can find! In this topic, you will learn about all of the different animals who live in the Jungle, the noises they make, the colour and patterns of their skins- what fun we will have as we 'rumble in the Jungle'.</p>	<p><b>Mad About Minibeasts (8 weeks)</b></p>  <p>At the bottom of the garden, you might hear a sound, a chirping in the treetops or a scuttle on the ground. If you step a little closer, maybe you can see a ladybird, a dragonfly, a beetle or a bee. The sun is in the sky; it's a lovely sunny day, the minibeasts have seen you and they want to come and play. In this topic, you will learn all about the different insects that live around you, from wiggly worms to curly caterpillars, you'll soon be 'mad about minibeasts!'</p>

Measuring and comparing each other.</p> <p>WK6: Grass Heads: children plant grass seeds to make a grass head funny face.</p> <p>WK7: Where do I live? Children share photos of their homes and family members. What can you tell me about your family?</p>	<p>WK1: Icy Igloo: using marshmallows to build igloos.</p> <p>WK2: Popsicle Painting: children paint with coloured ice.</p> <p>WK3: Making Paper Plate Penguins: children listen and follow single instructions.</p> <p>WK4: Making Polar Bears: children use cardboard tubes and different materials.</p> <p>WK5: Polar Bear cupcakes: children ice and decorate cupcakes.</p> <p>WK6: Fun in the Snow: children help to make and explore snow dough.</p> <p>WK7: Painting with shaving foam to create an artic picture.</p>	<p>WK 1: Sand and Shell Art children create sand scenes with shells and coloured sand.</p> <p>WK2: Super Starfish: children create bumpy starfish using cereal.</p> <p>WK3: Feed the Shark: children play a number and counting game.</p> <p>WK4: Jellyfish Sun Catchers: using different materials to explore light and colour.</p> <p>WK5: Ocean Slime – children make slime and explore texture.</p> <p>WK6: Handprint and Footprint Crafts: children create sea creatures using a printing technique.</p>	<p>WK1: Welly Walk: jumping in muddy puddles and collecting treasures.</p> <p>WK2: Making a nursery scarecrow.</p> <p>WK3: Sheering Sheep: children paint large sheep pictures with shaving foam.</p> <p>WK4: Milking the Cow: children ‘milk a cow’ through a rubber glove!</p> <p>WK5: Welly Printing: children walk through paint and other sensory materials for mark making.</p> <p>WK6: Small Word Farm; children act out the story’. Cock-a-doodle doo Barnyard Hullabaloo’ in the tuff tray.</p>	<p>WK1: Rumble in the Jungle: children use the small world Jungle to recreate the story.</p> <p>WK2: Super Snakes: children make paperchain snakes.</p> <p>WK3: Boldly Balancing: children balance along a ‘snakes’ of different heights and lengths.</p> <p>WK4: Amazing Animals: children match animals to the correct pattern.</p> <p>WK5: Animal Antics: children complete different animal craft activities.</p>	<p>WK1: Bugs Galore: children go on a bug hunt, taking photos of the bugs they find.</p> <p>WK2: Crafty Creatures: children use different materials to create different creatures.</p> <p>WK3: Bingo Bugs: children play a game of Bingo together.</p> <p>WK 4: Bug Watch: exploring bugs through magnifying glasses.</p> <p>WK5: Pebble Painting: children create bug pebbles.</p> <p>WK6: A Home for Bugs: children work together to build a Bug Hotel in the garden.</p> <p>WK7: Wriggling Worms: children use playdough to make different length worms.</p> <p>WK8: Cakey Caterpillars: children decorate mini rolls to look like caterpillars.</p>
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
