A big hello to you all from the Year Three Team to what we all hope will be an exciting and enjoyable Term 2 leading out to the Christmas Break.

'Active Planet' continues to be our topic in Term 2. We will learn about how natural phenomenon has an impact on humans, as well as the planet. The topic is primarily Geography based and during this term we will be moving onto applying field skills, including compass directions and grid references.
