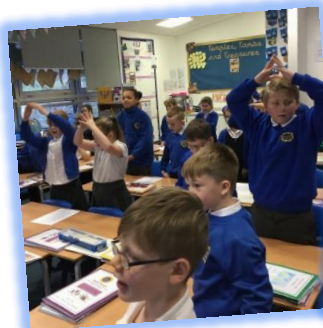


Year 4 - Term 3 Best Bits!
